<b>Stuttgart</b> <a href="http://www.flughafen-stuttgart.de">www.flughafen-stuttgart.de</a>	A mid-sized airport with lots of international and domestic flights, car rental facilities and easy access to a good train and bus network.
<b>Memmingen</b> <a href="http://www.allgaeu-airport.de/">http://www.allgaeu-airport.de/</a>	With Ryanair, <a href="http://www.ryanair.de">www.ryanair.de</a> , from London/Stansted and Edinburgh, Oslo and Stockholm. Or with Air Berlin from Berlin.
<b>Zurich</b> <a href="http://www.flughafen-zurich.ch">www.flughafen-zurich.ch</a>	International airport with good public transport means and car rental facilities.
<b>Basel/Mulhouse</b> <a href="http://www.euroairport.com/">www.euroairport.com/</a>	A mid-sized airport with lots of international and domestic flights. EasyJet, <a href="http://www.easyjet.com">http://www.easyjet.com</a> , from London/Gatwick, Amsterdam, Berlin and many more.



## BY CAR

### Germany

**via Stuttgart:** A81/A98 until you reach the end of the highway (exit Bodensee/Lindau). Then follow the B31 to Friedrichshafen.  
alternatively: Follow A8 and take exit Ulm West. Then follow B30 to Friedrichshafen

**via Würzburg/München:** A96 (heading Lindau) until you reach exit Sigmarszell/Friedrichshafen. Then follow B31 to Friedrichshafen.

**via Ulm:** Follow A8 and take exit Ulm West. Then follow B30 to Friedrichshafen

### Austria

**via Bregenz:** follow A14/A96 and take exit Sigmarszell/Friedrichshafen. And then B31 to Friedrichshafen.

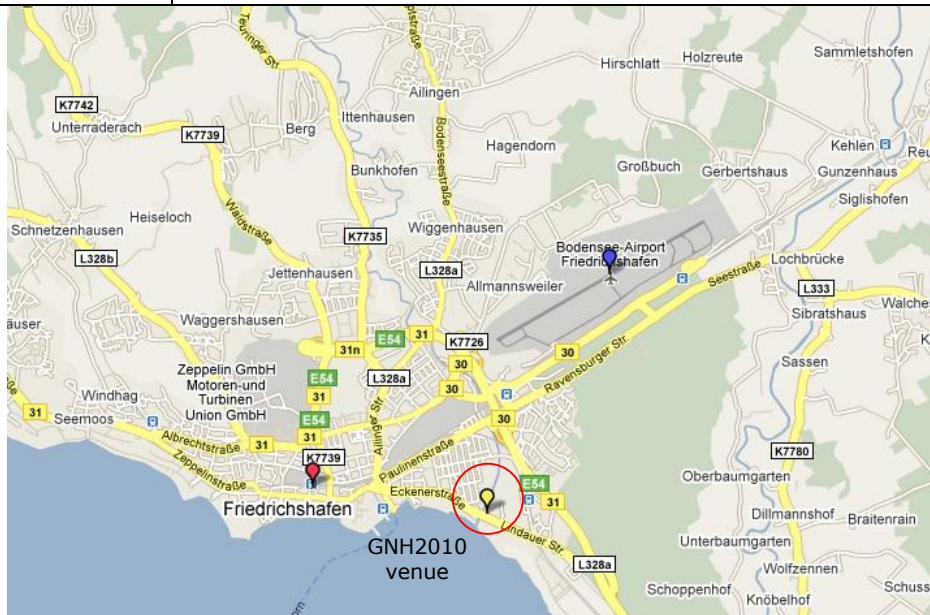
**via Salzburg:** via Munich on A96 until you reach exit Sigmarszell/Friedrichshafen. And then B31 to Friedrichshafen.

### Switzerland

**via Zurich:** N7 to Kreuzlingen/Konstanz. Take the car ferry from Konstanz to Meersburg. Then B31 to Friedrichshafen.

**via St. Gallen/Romanshorn:** N1 to Romanshorn. Then take the car ferry from Romanshorn to Friedrichshafen (hourly service).

<b>Germany</b>	<p>Take ICE/IC trains to Ulm and then connect to the InterRegioExpress (IRE) and RegionalExpress (RE) to Friedrichshafen.</p> <p>DB Reisezentrum Friedrichshafen: +49 (0)7541 201-385  Timetable: <a href="http://www.bahn.de">www.bahn.de</a></p>
<b>Austria</b>	<p>If you travel from the west of Austria use Öbb via Bregenz and Lindau.</p> <p>From the rest of Austria you are best off using Intercity trains to Munich and Ulm.</p> <p>Mobilitätscenter – Zug, Bahnbus:  Call +43 51717 or +43 512930000  Or visit the following website: <a href="http://www.oebb.at">www.oebb.at</a></p>
<b>Switzerland</b>    	<p>Take the SBB Basel-Lindau service and change at Lindau to the DB IR train to Friedrichshafen.  <p><b>From Friedrichshafen to the venue</b></p> 	<p>The venue is only 3 kilometers (or roughly 30 minutes) away from <b>Friedrichshafen Stadt Station</b>. There's also a bus service (number 7) that takes you to Eberhardstrasse stop which is as close as 50 metres from the venue. Or the RAB-bus service (7587) towards Kressbronn and get off at 'Jugendherberge' (youth hostel and GNH2010 venue).</p> <p>Or if you happen to arrive at <b>Friedrichshafen Hafen Station</b> walk to Romanshorner Platz and head East, Östliche Uferstrasse, along Lake Konstanz until you get to Rotachbrücke. Cross the bridge and you'll see the venue.</p> <p>From <b>Friedrichshafen Flughafen (Airport)</b> take the train to Friedrichshafen Hafen Station. From there follow the above description.</p> <p>From <b>Friedrichshafen Ost</b> (nearest to the venue) walk across 'Berufschulzentrum' roughly 500 metres until you get to the river Rotach. Turn left and head straight to the venue.</p> <p>The ways from all the above stations/stops will very likely be marked with flour up to the venue.</p>
